The border between Switzerland and France was opened in October 1944 following the allied landings in the south of France in 1944, and the évadés de guerre were able to return home. They were taken to Lyon and flown to Naples, which may seem a perverse route back to the United Kingdom but in fact made sense as many of the men were from other countries in the British Commonwealth and Naples was a sensible staging post for their dispersal. Major Dobson and a couple of other British officers remained in Switzerland
